THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING IS TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF THE NEED TO REPLACE OUR TREATMENT PLANT AND DISCUSS POTENTIAL FUNDING.

THE VILLAGE OF PRENTICE HAS A LOW MODERATE INCOME (LMI) RATE GREATER THAN 51% AND THIS WOULD MAKE THEM ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT. (CDBG)

THE CDBG FUNDING ELIGIBLE PROJECTS WOULD INCLUDE THE REPLACEMENT OF THE TREATMENT PLANT LOCATED ON GRANBERG ROAD.

THE PUBLIC NEEDS ADDRESSED IN THIS PROJECT ARE AS FOLLOWS: AGED FOUNDATION, CLASPING PIPES, EQUIPMENT BEYOND SERVICEABLE LIFE AND THE PLANT FUNCTION IS OBSOLETE.

THERE WILL BE ZERO RESIDENTIAL DISPLACEMENT OR LAND ACQUISITIONS
